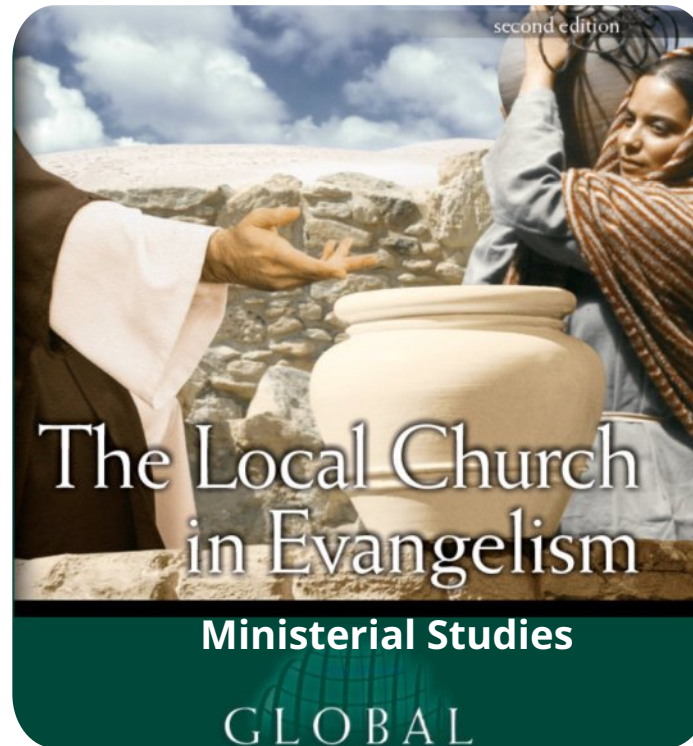


Course Objectives

7. Identify the role of pastoral leadership in the effectiveness of church evangelism.



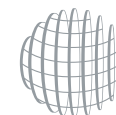
